This privacy policy document contains the types of information that is collected and stored by devPhantom SAS and how we use it. If you have additional questions or would like more information about our privacy policy, please contact us.

This privacy policy applies only to our online activities and applies to visitors to our website with respect to information they have shared and/or collected on Tendencyz. This policy does not apply to information collected offline or through channels other than this website.

Consent

By using our website, you hereby consent to our Privacy Policy and agree to its terms.

Information collect

The personal information that you are asked to provide, and the reasons why you are asked to provide it, will be made clear to you at the point we ask you to provide your personal information. If you contact us directly, we may receive additional information about you such as your name, email address, phone number, the contents of the message and/or attachments you may send us, and any other information you may choose to provide. When you register for an account, we may ask for your contact information, including items such as name, company name, address, email address, and telephone number.

How we use your information

We use the information we collect in various ways, including to:

- Provide, operate, and maintain our website/application
- Improve, personalize, and expand our website/application
- Understand and analyze how you use our website/application
- Develop new products, services, features, and functionality
- Communicate with you, either directly or through one of our partners, including for customer service, to provide you with updates and other information relating to the website, and for marketing and promotional purposes
- Send you emails
- Find and prevent fraud

Log files

Tendencyz follows a standard procedure of using log files. These files record visitors when they visit websites. All hosting companies do this and it is part of the analysis of the hosting services. Information collected by log files includes Internet Protocol (IP) addresses, browser type, Internet Service Provider (ISP), date and time, referring and exit pages, and possibly the number of clicks. This data is not linked to personally identifiable information. The purpose of this information is to analyze trends, administer the site, track users' movements around the site and gather demographic information.

Cookies and Web Beacons

Like any other website, Tendencyz uses 'cookies'. These cookies are used to store information including visitors' preferences, and the pages on the website that the visitor accessed or visited. The information is used to optimize the users' experience by customizing our web page content based on visitors' browser type and/or other information.

Website / Application

Privacy Policies of Advertising Partners

You can view this list to find the privacy policy of each of Tendencyz's advertising partners. GDPR Data Protection Rights
